Venue information & accessibility:

Brownlow House is a stunning country manor in Northern Ireland overlooking the scenic surroundings of Lurgan Park.

Is the venue easy to find?

Yes, Brownlow House is located in Lurgan town centre, at the top of Windsor Avenue, just beside Lurgan Park. There is also a Heritage sign posted within the town making it easy to find. Please use postcode BT67 9BJ

Please note there are about 12-15 steps at the main entrance to Brownlow House. There is disabled access with no steps if required, please inform us prior to arriving if this is required.
